Please find attached the 1st substantive revision to the Vocational Training project document (MPTF Project 102176), as per the attached signed document by the parties. We are also attaching a copy of the signed original project document for your records.

The document was signed by UNDP Brazil, UNDP Haiti, INFP-Ministry of National Education and Professional Formation of Haiti, Brazilian Agency Cooperation and the National Service for Industrial Formation of Brazil.

This project revision attends to the Government of Haiti's request to increase the quantity of Vocational Training Centre/VTC beyond one in Les Cayes, according to the original project document. The project now aims to implant and implement 02 other VTCs, one in St. Marc and one in Fort-Liberté. The project budget remains the same in the amount of US\$ 16,830,000.00 but its validity was extended from December 31st, 2019 to December 31st, 2020.

UNDP Brazil received a request from the Ministry of External Relations, Government of Brazil, to verify the possibility of extending the HRF board to December 2020, to cover the validity of the ongoing project (Vocational Training and Health) in PAP/Haiti.

We look forward for your answer with regard to the extension of Reconstruction Fund mission in Haiti until December 31st, 2020.

#### 1" SUBSTANTIVE REVISION

PROJECT BRA/16/004 - Support to Technical and Vocational Education and Training in Haiti through the Establishment of a Vocational Training Center and Related Institutional Strengthening

#### CONTEXT

Project BRA/16/004 — "Support to Technical and Vocational Education and Training in Haiti through the Establishment of a Vocational Training Center and Related Institutional Strengthening" addresses the imperative to pursue the expansion of technical, occupational and vocational education, job generation, and social promotion in Haiti.

The project rests on four pillars of intervention: (i) building a fully equipped vocational training center; (ii) performing institutional strengthening actions to support *Institut National de Formation Professionnelle et Technique* (INFP); (iii) offering a training and educational program for the target population, supported by a set of community outreach activities carried out by the National Services for Industrial Learning (SENAI), from Brazil, with the support of INFP and other partner entities with a view to raise boys' and girls' interest to pursue technical and vocational education; and (iv) project management, monitoring and evaluation.

A thorough analysis of the Haltian labor market will be considered to identify current demand and map future demand for skilled workers by local industry and the potential for self-employment. In this sense, the project will promote exchange of good practices in education between Brazil and Haiti, learning from the Brazilian experience with its nationwide network of vocational schools offered by SENAI.

Project implementation refers to UNDP Brazil as the project implementing partner, SENAI as the provider of technical expertise and the Brazilian Cooperation Agency (ABC) as the responsible for the monitoring, evaluation and project co-coordination, and UNDP Haiti as the implementing agency of specific outputs of the project. Direct beneficiaries of the project include the INFP and the *Ministère de l'Education Nationale et de la Formation Professionnelle* (MENFP).

Project initial revision was signed in August 2016 with a total budget of US\$ 17,000,000.00. On October 2016, resources from the MPTF were transferred to UNDP Brazil in the total amount of USD 16,830,000 (1% of the total budget, equivalent to US\$ 170,000.00, was retained to cover MPTF's operational costs).

Project implementation was postponed to 2017, due to the presidential electoral period held in November 2016. After the assumption of the new government on March 2017, a series of meetings were established with the parties involved with project's implementation focusing on the launch of activities. In 2017, 3 (three) missions were held with the participation of representatives from the new Government of Halti (GoH); SENAI, ABC, UNDP Brazil and UNDP Haiti.

During the first mission in Haiti, held in May 2017, the GoH, through its new director of the INFP, requested the revision of the project to increase the number of Vocational Training Centers (VTC) from one to three. He also indicated the possible sites for the VTC's Installation: Les Cayes, St. Marc and Fort Liberté. Participants of the mission visited these locations and prepared an assessment confirming the places and informing the thematic courses to be offered.

The other two missions took place in Brazil, when the discussions regarding the change in the project's scope were expanded and deepened. During the second mission, held in July 2017, a delegation of representatives



from GoH visited Brasília and Porto Alegre, in Brazil, and met the Brazilian counterparts of the Project. Highlight of this mission was a visit to SENAI's VTC in Porto Alegre, when the delegation agreed on the training's areas of the Haitian VTCs as stated below:

- Les Cayes 5 (five) vocational areas: métal mechanics, information technology, civil construction, refrigeration, automotive mechanics;
- Fort Liberté 3 (three) vocational areas: civil construction, refrigeration and information technology;
- Saint Marc-- 2 (two) vocational areas: information technology and civil construction.

The third mission was held in October 2017 in Brasilia, Brazil, with the purpose of presenting a new project's budget proposal elaborated by UNDP Brazil and SENAI to attend the 1st mission's request by INFP to build, maintain and put in place 03 VTCs. An Aide-Mémoire, was signed by the parts establishing the general guidelines for the project budget proposal (please refer to Annex 1).

With the purpose to meet the demands from the INFP and present the new project scope and budget, the Steering Committee met twice in 2017 (please refer to the minutes attached in Annexes 2 and 3). In April 2018, in a bilateral meeting between GoB and GoH, an agreement was reached to implement the project revision with the budget presented in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Steering Committee that took place on the 14<sup>th</sup> of December (see ABC official letter in the Annex 4). Based on this agreement, INFP approved the proposal, which is being reflected in the present project substantive revision.

#### **REVISION OBJECTIVES**

This project revision has the following objectives:

- Extend project duration until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020;
- Expand the number of Vocational Training Centers from 1 to 3, upon availability of funds. They will be located in Les Cayes Center, Fort Liberté and Saint Marc.;
- iii) Update the PRRF;
- iv) Update the Annual Workplan;
- v) Redefine the responsible party for each output of the project, taking into consideration that UNDP Haiti and INFP will be responsible for the "hard" components (equipment, construction, furniture) and SENAI and UNDP Brazil will be responsible for the "soft" components (knowledge building and transfer, training, project overall management).
- vi) Reflect the new project budget presented in the Project Steering Committee on December 14, 2017;
- vii) Reflect the expenses incurred in 2017;
- viii) To relocate the unspent balance of 2017 for the year 2018;
- ix) Reflect SENAI as of Responsible Party of the budget description 72100 to the Outputs 1.4, 2.1, 2.3, 3.1, 3.2, 3.3 and 4.1.

It's important to mention that activities included in the project through the present revision, especially those related to the construction of the additional 2 VTC, will be implemented upon availability of resources.

#### BUDGET

The total amount of the budget remains the same, although there is a significant increase in the project scope. In order to meet the Brazilian audit rules and follow up the Aide-Mémoire statements, it was established that the project budget should keep a balance of 50-50% between "hard" components (construction, equipment and furniture), and "soft" components (knowledge building and transfer, training and project overall management).

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#### JUSTIFYING TO THE ADDITION OF SENAI AS OF RESPONSIBLE PARTY

The original strategy of the project identified SENAI as a Brazilian technical partner responsible to knowledge transfer and training activities. This was confirmed by the Aide Memoire signed in October 2017 by the project participating partners. In this sense, considering the budget division of Hard and Soft components, SENAI now will be responsible to implement the budget account 72:100 listed in the Outputs 1.4, 2.1, 2.3, 3.1, 3.2, 3.3 regarding to training programs, institutional capacity development of INFP and part of the management of each three VTC that totalize US\$ 4,753,979,92.

In this context, in order to operationalize and bring agility to SENAI's activities response to the project UNDP reflected SENAI as of responsible party of the components/outputs described above and marked below in the Multi-Year Work Plan.

#### PROJECT BRA/16/004: VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTER – BRAZIL/HAITI AIDE-MÉMOIRE - Brasilia, October 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup>

A mission within the scope of the Project. "Vocation Training Center Brazil/Haiti" was carried out in Brazilla, from October 24th to 27th, alming at negotiating and approving the general guidelines for the new project budget proposal, in order to meet the demands from the INFP.

During the meetings, emphasis was put on the importance of all parties involved ensuring the project sustainability, which also includes availability of budget resources.

The Brazilian Government clarified that all measures related to the project implementation shall be based on the principles of south-south cooperation and equality. In this sense, the Brazilian expertise shall always be adapted to fit the partners' needs.

SENAI's team presented an overview of the budget plan, expected results and deliverables.

In order to meet the Brazilian audit rules, all partners agreed not to use more than 50% of budget resources in construction works and equipment; so that a balance is kept between "hard" components (construction, equipment) and "soft" component (knowledge transfer and training and other project costs).

All partners agreed on starting off by prioritizing the budget and activities for Les Cayes Center.

The construction of two other centers - Fort Liberté and Saint Marc, should stant both at the same time but shortly after the beginning of Les Cayes Center construction.

SENAl emphasized the importance of ending all of construction activities of the three centers at the same time – meaning that the "soft" component schedule will be prepared according with the delivery deadline.

The INFP agreed with the scale economy proposed by SENAL it means that all activities shall be ended at the same time, with a view to optimizing financial and human resources.

UNDP Haitl and INFP will be the responsible parties in the component related to construction and equipment ("bard" component - referring to project outputs 1.1; 1.3; 2.4).

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








The responsibilities of each partner were clarified and all partners agreed on the project implementation strategy as follows:



The SENAt team will be solely responsible for delivering knowledge transfer and training activity ("soft" component - referring to project outputs 2.1, 2.2, 2:3), and shall work in collaboration with INFP in this regard.

It was agreed that, who never required, UNDP HaltI and INFP may invite SENAI to visit the site locations and provide any suggestions related to the infrastructure layout plan and construction of the centers.

HNDP Brazil and ABC are in charge of the overall supervision of the project.

INFP informed that the property title and other legal documents for Les Cayes Center had been sent to UNDP Haitl. Other two legal documents related to Fort Liberté and Saint Marc will be provided over the following 2 weeks from this date.

INFP committed to finance the purchase of the necessary equipment for Fort Liberté and Soint Marc. In addition, they have indicated that they would work together with UNDP Haiti in order to faunch a procurement process encompassing all the three centers. All necessary arrangements, specially the financial component are to be established by INFP and UNDP Haiti in the short-term. It is important to highlight that SENAI suggested that the equipment be delivered at each one of the three centers at the same time.

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All parties agreed on the following about each center:

- Les Cayes (4.500 m2): five vocational areas: metal mechanics, information technology, civil construction, refrigeration, automotive mechanics;
- Fort Liberté (1.280 m2): three vocational areas: civil construction, refrigeration, information technology;
- Saint Marc (1.080 m2); two vocational areas: Information technology and civil construction.

UNDP Haitl and INFP will be responsible for carrying out preparing the technical specifications and a first pricing of the market in order to launch the final hidding process. INFP will submit the standard lists of equipment which are currently used in Haiti. In addition, SENAI will submit two different lists of equipment, one with standard equipment and another with more sophisticated equipment for each of the vocational areas for INFP's approval.

INFP approved SENAI's request for reducing in approximately 200m2 the hitially area size that INFP had initially proposed, that is, 4,700 m2, for setting up Les Cayes Center. In doing so, SENAI will be able to ensure that monitoring missions are carried out according to the necessary regularity, in this sense, the final area size of Les Cayes Center will be approximately 4,500 m2.

Regarding Les Cayes Center, it was agreed that the final amount for investment in "hard" component (equipment and construction) should not exceed the limit of 5.5 million of dollars.

SENAI assumed the responsibility to analyze the didactic material developed by REDITP (Red de Instituciones de Formación Profesional de America Central, Haiti y República Daminicano), with the purpose of getting acquainted with such resources and knowledge, and understanding the standard applied, so as to harmonize it with the Brazilian methodology.

All parties agreed with ABC's recommendations about establishing only one official communication channel among the parties, which should be centered on the Brazilian Embassy in Port-au-Prince, Haiti.

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Finally, the parties agreed on the guidelines for the "soft" component. Nevertheless, the budget details will be analyzed and approved during II Steering Committee Meeting, to be held by the end of November, 2017.

Brasilla - DF, March 30th, 2017

#### Background:

Following a mission to Porto Alegre in July, 2017, with the participation of ABC, INFP, UNDP Brazil, SENAI-DN and SENAI-RS, SENAI-DN representatives undertook to prepare a new budget contemplating the new scenario demanded by INFP, with the change from one to three vocational training centers.

Two months after the budget review request, SENAI presented to ABC and UNDP Brazil, on September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017, a new project proposal, providing for the construction of the three vocational training centers, as agreed with INFP. Among others, significant changes were identified in relation to the original project:

- Budget of US\$ 18.8 million instead of the US\$ 17 million allocated;
- Allegation that the scope of the project would shift from "institutional strengthening" to "implementation of training centers";
- Drastic reduction of hours of training and trained professionals;
- o Preparation of didactic material only by SENAI, excluding Haltian participation in the process;
- Reduction of SENAI's permanence period in the Project after completion of the works (from 24 to 12 months);
- Expectation of short term construction for all vocational training centers (18 months, in the scenario of simultaneous construction of the three centers).

There being no time to analyze the new budget sent by SENAI, it was decided not to address the budget theme in the 1st SC. SENAI then limited itself to submit to the Haitian government a summary of the changes proposed to the project.

- Mr. Trebucq, Country Director of UNDP Brazil, opened the SC and suggested the following agenda:
  - 1 Definition the Steering Committee and Technical Group members explaining the role of each one;
  - 2 Formal approval by the Steering Committee for the three Vocational Training Centers to be incorporated to the project BRA/16/004 and definition of the 1<sup>st</sup> VTC to be executed in Les Cayes and its procedures;
  - 3 Propose new data to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Steering Committee meeting and to the 1<sup>st</sup> Technical Group in order to present and approve the new project's budget;
  - 4 Discuss about the expenses to the stone launch in Les Cayes according mentioned on the Letter sent by the GoB/ABC/MER dated as of August 28<sup>th</sup> in the name of ABC/GoB, UNDP Brazil, UNDP Haiti and SENAI, see attached.
  - 5 If we still have free time we can discuss another important but strategic issue.
  - Mr. Trebucq and Mr. Seferin, ABC Chancellery Officer, reinforced their commitment to building three
    centers.
  - Mr. Cajuste Charlorin, Director of Planning and External Cooperation of INFP, made official the desire
    to use architectural prototypes and projects already developed by the Caribbean Bank, as well as
    professional training programs prepared by the consulting firm CRC Sogema and to hire French
    teachers.
  - Ms. Maguy Durcé, Director of INFP, requested that the project cover expenses (ex: launching of the cornerstone) that was not originally foreseen in the project design.
  - Ms. Maristela Baioni, UNDP program coordinator for Brazil, pointed out that the project was
    designed under the Brazilian South-South Cooperation framework, and that it was important to
    guarantee exchange of Knowledge between both countries. The use of previous studies and the use
    of third-party program from other countries would move the project away from its essence, that is a
    SSC between Brazil and Haiti.

- Mr. Seferin, ABC, reiterated that the core of cooperation in this project is knowledge transfer, an
  element that would be lost if methodologies of other foreign cooperation were used. In addition, the
  use of architectural projects of previous cooperation would not be in accordance with the quality
  standards stipulated by SENAI.
- Mrs. Durcé emphasized the need to accelerate the construction of Les Cayes, as stated in the project document: excellence center.
- Mr. Lamego, Head of the International Area of SENAI, informed about the minimum quality standard observed by SENAI for the construction of professional centers and also pointed out that if the construction of Les Cayes is prioritized, the plan for the simultaneous construction of the three centers proposed by SENAI should be revised, which will incur additional costs for not optimizing resources (especially technical hours).
- Ms. Durcé reported that the launching of the cornerstone, which was attended by the President of
  Haitl, Mr. Moïse, and the Brazilian Ambassador to Haitl, Mr. Vidal, in Les Cayes made official the
  political commitment for the beginning of the project with the construction of the vocational training
  center. The priority for the launch of Les Cayes was reaffirmed by the Haitian government.
- Mrs. Durcé understood that the launching ceremony sealed the Brazilian consent to the terrain and a reduced deadline for the beginning of the works.
- Ms. Ana Luiza Membrive, Counselor of the Brazilian Embassy in Haiti, pointed out that the Ambassador's presence at the ceremony did not ratify unllateral decisions and had not been duly approved by the Executive Steering Committee of the project, as provided for in the Agreement.

- Ms. Martine Therré, Program Director, UNDP Haiti, and Mrs. Durcé were surprised by the
  presentation made by SENAI-DN. It was their expectation that the Center of Les Cayes would remain
  with the same dimension/size and structure of the initial project, as an excellence center.
- ABC commented that Mrs. Durce would have agreed to build smaller centers and opted for three
  reference centers instead of a center of excellence during the mission to Porto Alegre last July when
  field visits were made to units of SENAI-RS.
- ABC also argued that it would not be possible to maintain the initially planned size of the Les Cayes Center with a view to the inclusion of two new Centers.
- Given the impasse in the negotiations, the unexpected demands of the Haitian side, and for the time being exhausted, the meeting was closed by Mr. Trebucq.
- Mr. Trebucq proposed to convene a meeting of the Technical Committee of the Project and ABC suggested that the second meeting of the SC to be held soon.

#### General considerations:

The need for better articulation and alignment between UNDP Brazil and UNDP Haiti.

Improve communication between all partners in order to minimize bilaterals involving INFP and other partners.

Define INFP communication flows with partners (UNDP Haiti and Brasemb Haiti) in order to improve the fluidity and uniqueness of the official demands of the government of Haiti.

#### Forwarding:

ABC will have a meeting on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 with UNDP Brazil, to review the budget, and on September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017 with UNDP Brazil and SENAI.

Note: SENAl's International area will be outside Brazil from October 10<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and therefore unavailable for project actions.

A high-level conversation is required between partners to level the project's understanding and the responsibilities of each cooperating party. To this end, it is suggested to assign a mission to Haiti for a face-to-face meeting or to schedule a new mission from INFP and UNDP Haiti to Brazil, at an early date.

Perform a prospecting mission to the Paula de Souza High School and Technical Center (São Paulo).

Request SENAI to simulate different budgets with other scenarios, especially with priority to the construction of Les Cayes.

Brasilia - DF, December 21, 2017

#### Background:

- As a main result of the Haitian mission held in Brasilia from 24th to 27<sup>th</sup> of October 2017r, with the participation of ABC, INFP, UNDP Brazil, UNDP Haiti, SENAI-DN and SENAI-RS, it was agreed that a maximum of 50% of the budget would be applied to the hard component (construction, furniture, and equipment) and 50% to the soft component (transfer of knowledge, training, overall management costs, and other costs).
- In addition, it was agreed that UNDP Haiti and INFP would be responsible for the implementation of the hard component and SENAI and UNDP Brazil for the soft component.
- In view of the budgetary adjustment necessary to cover the construction of the three centers and the insufficiency of project funds to cover all the costs of purchasing equipment, INFP assumed the responsibility for these costs for the Fort Liberté and Saint Marc Centers.
- Considering that there was not enough time to detail the budget of the soft component in the previous meeting, it was agreed that the respective budget would be approved in the Second Meeting of the Steering Committee, scheduled for the 14<sup>th</sup> of December, 2017.
- On December 8th, ABC received from UNDP Brazil an e-mail containing new demands from the INFP regarding the hiring of personnel (not foreseen in the previous negotiations, which would involve 15 "translation posts", and 1 project manager, 3 local coordinators (Cayes, SM, FL), 1 person as a mediator (intermediary) between the local authorities (deputes, mayors, etc) and the project staff.

#### Report:

- On December 14th, 2017, the 2nd Steering Committee Meeting of the Brazil-Haiti Professional Training Center Project was held by videoconference with the participation of ABC, INFP, UNDP Brazil and UNDP Haiti.
- UNDP Brazil opened the meeting by reiterating that the main objective of this meeting would be to approve the proposed budget according to the Aide Memoire signed at ABC on October 27, 2017, previously sent by UNDP to the INFP.
- Mr. Alex Chérenfant, INFP engineer and adviser, expressed the agreement of the Institute to the budget in general terms. Nonetheless, he reiterated the new recruitment demands that had been submitted to UNDP Brazil prior to the meeting, so that Haiti could be included in the leadership of the project.
- Mr. Tomás Seferin, ABC Chancellery Official, stressed that, given the already agreed flow of communication between the partners, it is necessary to formalize these demands through the Embassy of Brazil in Port-au-Prince/PAP.
- The ABC representative clarified that the Agency recognizes the merit of the INFP's request regarding the appointment of Haitian coordinators to act as counterparts to the SENAI coordinators. However, this should be seen as a counterpart of the Haitian government, that is, INFP officials to be designated and trained for this function.
- It was also clarified by ABC that, according to the guidelines of the Technical International Cooperation, the Brazilian government can't provide resources, through technical cooperation projects, to pay employees' salaries of the partner institution.
- Ms. Durcé challenged the arguments presented by ABC as well as highlighted her disagreement over the amount of \$ 140,000.00 in line 8.10 of the budget for INFP logistics costs. According to the director general of INFP, this figure represents only 1% of the total budget of the project, which would not be in line with their expectations.

- Ms. Yvonne Helle, Country Director of UNDP Haiti, expressed her agreement with the budget and favorably to Mrs. Durcé's demands for the soft component. Regarding the hard component, under the responsibility of UNDP Haiti, she argued that Haiti was already adequately covered in coordination posts.
- In this regard, Mr. Didier, country director of UNDP Brazil, asked to be updated on the necessary measures to start the works as an executive project and bidding processes. Ms. Helle claimed that she had not taken the necessary steps because she was unaware of the urgency of the Brazilian partners. However, she said that UNDP Haiti will carry out the necessary steps to start the activities, given the reaction concerns on the Brazilian side, reiterating the need to speed up the procedures.
- Regarding land property documents, Mr. Alex Chérenfant reported that two of the three documents required have already been submitted to UNDP Haiti and the third will be delivered shortly. In this regard, ABC requested that all three documents be sent to the Brazilian Embassy in Port-au-Prince.
- It is important to note that during the meeting it was not possible to discuss and approve with the INFP the budget of the soft part of the project, but there was a common understanding that the budget for the hard component (construction, equipment and furniture) had already been approved since the last mission of the representatives of the INFP to Brazil, which took place in October 2017.
- Finally, UNDP Brazil was responsible for the creation of an e-mail group that put together all the partners involved in the negotiation and execution of the project, in order to harmonize the exchange of information.
